Building **WHEREAS** Council for the Town of Morris is empowered under Part 7, Division 2, Sections 231, 232 and 233 of The Municipal Act, to pass a By-Law with respect to the condition and maintenance of vacant residential and commercial buildings; and

WHEREAS vacant and derelict buildings may create harmful visual impacts, increase risk of arson or vandalism, negatively affect property values, and pose risks to public safety and neighborhood stability; and

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and in the public interest to establish a By-Law to regulate the condition and maintenance of vacant, unsafe and unsightly buildings and to provide a process by which the Municipality may take title to vacant and derelict buildings in accordance with Section 247.2(1) of The Municipal Act; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council for the Town of Morris gives First Reading to By-Law No. 02-26– Vacant and Derelict Buildings By-Law.
